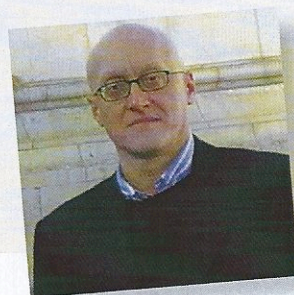


## Prof. Marco Rossi



*Dr. Marco Rossi is an Associate Professor in Anesthesia and Intensive Care, Faculty of Medicine of the Catholic University of Rome, Italy.*

*He graduated in Medicine at the Faculty of Medicine of the Catholic University in Rome in 1984, followed by a specialization in Anesthesia and Intensive Care in 1987, and in 2007 took over as an Associate Professor. From 1991 until 2003, he specialised in general anesthesia and pain medicine at the Unit of Cardiac Anesthesia & Postoperative Intensive Care, University Hospital "Agostino Gemelli", Rome. During this period he also refined his expertise in hemodynamic monitoring and transesophageal echocardiography at Pediatric Cardiac Surgery of the Children Hospital, Boston and subsequently in France and the Netherlands. From 2003 until 2012, he was the Director of the Department of Anesthesia, Intensive Care and Pain Medicine at the Foundation Johannes Paulus II, Catholic University, Campobasso, Italy and in July 2012, became the coordinator responsible for specialist surgeries, non-operating room anesthesia and peri-operative medicine at the University Hospital "Agostino Gemelli" in Rome.*

*He is a member of the Italian Society of Anesthesia (SIAARTI) and Italian Society of Intensive Care (SITI), and since 2005, has participated in the Research Group in Cardiothoracic and Vascular Anesthesia. He is also the Section Editor of Minerva Anestesiologica for Cardiac Anesthesia since 2010.*

*Assoc. Prof. Rossi's main research interest is in the area of cardiac anesthesia, coagulation and inflammation, peri-operative medicine and clinical nutrition, and invasive pain medicine.*
