PATIENT FOCUS

Quality of care, welcoming environments, attention to a personal relationship with patients and relatives are distinctive features of the medical assistance offered by the University Hospital. Each patient is cared for individually by a referring doctor, who coordinates consultations between specialists in different areas.

THE UNIVERSITY HOSPITAL

Designed according to the most modern criteria for hospital building, the University Hospital stands at the centre of the campus. Equipped with 18 operating rooms and a heliport, it can accommodate up to 400 beds in single and double rooms. Its architecture and furnishings are intended to ensure high levels of comfort. Separate access paths designated for different patients and visitors guarantee safety and respect for privacy. Structural flexibility allows for rapid adjustments of spaces according to the evolution of technology and methods of care.

SERVICES

The Hospital includes Out-Patient, Day-Hospital and Day-Surgery departments, In-Patient wards, and the Health Centre for the Elderly. In addition, there is an Out-Patients' Clinic and a Radiotherapy Centre at the facilities in Via Longoni. The services are accessible through the National Public Health System.

TEACHING HOSPITAL

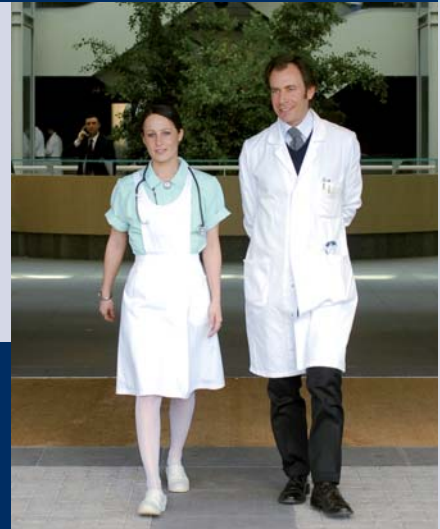
The Hospital is designed as a teaching hospital in which clinical activity is purpose-oriented towards operator training, open to interdisciplinary work and linked to research activities.

EXCELLENCE OF THE NURSING STAFF

The University care programme recognises the key role of nursing staff in the quality of the services supplied. The staff is entrusted with important coordinating tasks. Its academic training has always been a point of excellence of the University.

HEALTH CENTRE FOR THE ELDERLY (CESA)

CESA is devoted to medical assistance and applied research in the pathology of ageing. It is equipped with Out-Patient departments, In-Patient wards, an Alzheimer evaluation unit, physical therapy and rehabilitation services. It includes the Day Centre for the Frail, run by personnel and volunteers from the Alberto Sordi non-profit Association. CESA was founded with the actor's support.
